EditShare Application Programming Interface (API)

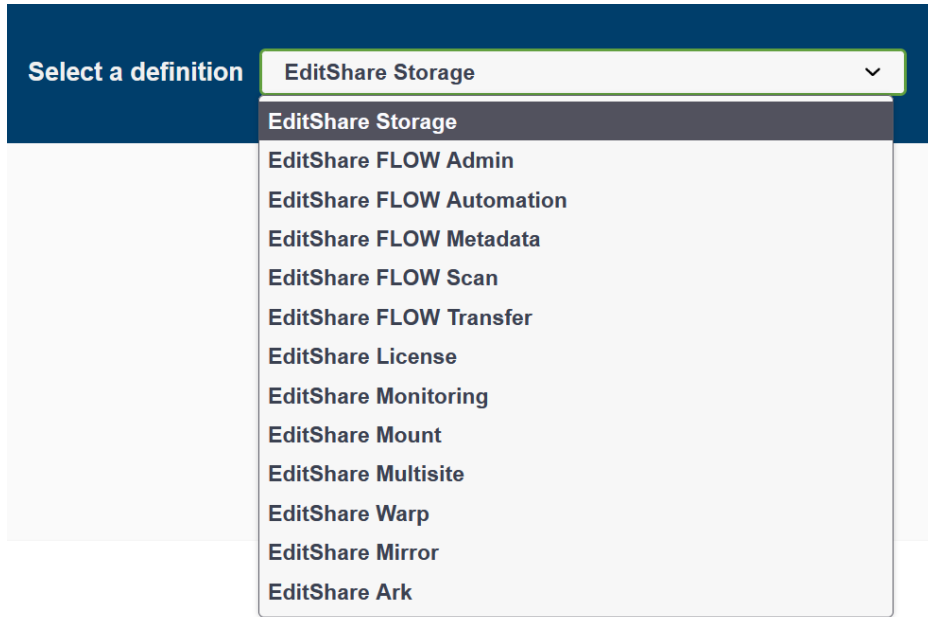
EditShare has APIs to access the functionality available on our systems. These are used internally by EditShare clients and services, but can also be used for Third Party products or as a way to connect internal systems to EditShare.

EditShare uses RESTful web APIs, exposed over HTTPS and using JSON as the interchange format. Access to the API is authenticated and user permissions are enforced.

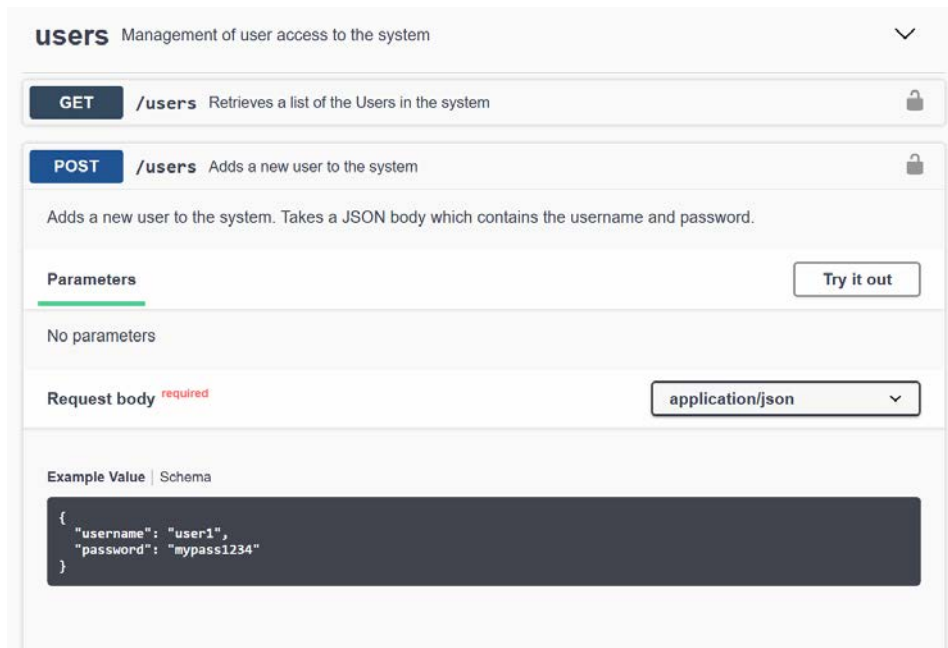

The EditShare API is available from any server within an EditShare system. The `editshare-gateway` service runs on port 8006 of EditShare servers and will ensure that any requests are routed to the correct server.
